Yes.

> and if so how do i do it?

Wel, just do it. If you call some procedure X in a program, IDL searches the path for a file x.pro, which it compiles then. Look at \$IDL_DIR/lib, there are many IDL routines, written in IDL.

I your file X contains a procedure Z, then you need to compile the file x.pro beforehand (.compile x), so IDL can find the routine Z when it needs it.
