> anyone could please explain how I can do this it would be very
> appreciated. Thanks!

One way to do this is to save the main window TLB identifier as a user value for your toolbar TLB. Then, whenever you write an event_pro for a button on your toolbar, you can include the lines:

```
widget_control, event.top, get_uvalue=main_tlb  
widget_control, main_tlb, get_uvalue=info
```
