I print IDL-generated graphics on CYMK printers all the time, usually by including TIFFs in a layout or drawing program, or by making EPS files and sticking them in work-processing files. Usually the printer driver does a fine job of converting the colour space, but if I want to do it manually I just fire up Photoshop or Illustrator. The last thing I want is RSI wasting their programmers' time trying to compete with Adobe.
