If you're using the OpenLook GUI, the widget_slider documentation says that you can use the "scroll" keyword to specify the 'step distance'. I guess this doesn't apply to other GUI's. Otherwise, you may have to do something using the "suppress_value" keyword of the slider and using a widget_label for displaying your own values generated by get_value of the slider and set_value of the label commands when the slider is moved.
