IDL should have a true WYSIWYG for graphics. Something that allows me to click on an axis displayed on the screen and change the range, font size, etc. Then let me click on the graphic, copy it, and paste it into another application. Sure PostScript produces beautiful printed output but most of the graphics I need are written to the screen, either directly or through another application program.

If EXCEL, PSI Plot, Dplot, etc., can do it, why can't IDL. And Dplot is free, not \$1700 or so.
