This should be an easy one for you.

I am using LABEL_DATE to produce a time axis in object graphics as follows:

TickFormat = 'Label_Date',Location=[0, 0.2,0])
;......
```

I expect the HOURS to appear below the date. This works in direct graphics but in object graphics it does not understand !C as a directive and instead displays it as a literal.
