> on this. How can I make the sample code below close all open widgets when I hit the "Quit" button? Right now, only the
> "firstBase" widget object closes, and the "secondBase" widget object remains open.

Change this line:

```
secondBase = WIDGET_BASE( GROUP_LEADER = group_leader )
```

To this:

```
secondBase = WIDGET_BASE( GROUP_LEADER = firstBase )
```
