> My current, and very ugly, technique is to have an array filled with
> ['01', '02', ... '12'], and then reference the appropriate entry. It
> works, but I don't like it.

I'd try something like this:

```
IDL> base = 'myfile'  
IDL> ext = '.dat'  
IDL> for j=1,12 do print, base + String(j, Format="(I2.2)") + ext
```
