Hi,

good question! Well I just played with this and got a solution. First, I would suggest saving the value of ![xy]tickname before you set it, and then afterwards restore the value (this way your application wont change the system variable. If you don't care what it was before, then the following seem to work:

```
![xy].tickname = strarr(30)
```

Seems that a good rule of thumb is to look at the system variables value when you start idl (to get the default settings)
