I just thought of another reason why RSI should leave this alone.

If the page was really rotated to landscape mode (as opposed to seascape mode) then the Y offset, which currently points in the -X direction, would be pointing... let's see, in the positive X direction and the X offset would have to be subtracted, let's see, from the short page side. Or...do I have this backwards? :-(
