- > me absolutely insane for the past 24-hours!

Indeed, RSI confirms this behavior, in which a single color is loaded into the color table in the PRINTER device at \*any\* location and then becomes the background color, is a bug.

The color, however, is only "officially" loaded into the correct position in the color table, so one work-around is to simply get and reload the color table vectors. My code looks something like this:

yellow = GetColor("yellow", !D.Table_Size-3); Load single color TVLCT, r, g, b, /Get; These two lines are work-around. TVLCT, r, g, b
TV, scaledImage
```
