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Hi all. I have a (hopefully) simple question about the CW\_FORM routine:

I'm creating a set of nonexclusive buttons, and I want to set the default values all at once using the set\_value keyword... The problem is, how do I set multiple values? For example:

```
IDL>d=['1,base,,column',  
      '0, button, ok, quit',  
      '2, button, option1|option2|option3|option4, set_value=1 0 0 1']  
IDL>a=cw_form(desc,/column)
```

How do I make, for example, option1 and option4 set by default? I've tried set\_value=1001, set\_value=[1,0,0,1], set\_value=1|0|0|1 and various other combinations, but nothing seems to work... Any ideas?
