|> Seems that a good rule of thumb is to look at the system variables value
|> when you start idl (to get the default settings)

I find this useful... In my wavestartup file (I don't know what the corresponding IDL startup file is), I have:

```
SAVE, Filename='/home/Wave/system.vars', /System
```

Then, I have a 'clean.com' script that does (among other things):

```
RESTORE, '/home/Wave/system.vars'
```

This makes a very convenient way of restoring all the system variables. It's a bit overkill to save them every time I start WAVE, but this way it's a no-brainer when WAVE upgrades, and the SAVE file format and system variables change....
