IDL> Print, File_Test('image.gif')
```

```
0
```

```
IDL> Print, File_Test('image.tif')
```

```
1
```

File_Test has many fancy keywords for "what kind of file do you expect to
find?", etc.:

```
[, /DIRECTORY | , /EXECUTABLE | , /READ | , /REGULAR | , /WRITE | ,  
/ZERO_LENGTH] [, GET_MODE=variable]
```
