- > That will solve your problem. :-)

David, it always helps when you are being specific. You are too far ahead for most of us to catch up. I too had a problem figuring out what you've meant by "any time IDL is looking for file names automatically, it always assumes all lowercase characters. It does this **specifically** so these programs will run on UNIX machines" :-)

- > Files that are named properly--lowercase characters, last
- > program module in the file has the same name as the file,
- > located in the IDL path, etc.--never have to be explicitly
- > compiled. IDL just finds them, compiles them, and runs them
- > when they are needed.
