I believe you are still running IDLWAVE 4.5. Try C-h v idlwave-mode-version RET H> OK, I've found the problem. It is not related to idlwave. I'm running CDE H> on HP-UX and it appears that if I launch something from the deskop (like H> XEmacs), it does not run in my own environment. So it has no access to my H> environment variables. Can you believe this? It took me quite long to H> find out. I sure can believe this. It is a common setup problem.
