> The problem I am seeing is that the FINDFILE function doesn't properly > interpret a "~" as a symbol for the home directory. >
Unfortunately my version is just slightle "more recent" than yours (SunOs, IDL 3.1.1), but I can confirm that "bug".
What I do to overcome that is to test every filename in the following way:
- starting with '~' > change to getenv('HOME')
- starting with '\$XYZ' > change to getenv('XYZ')
starting with neither '.' nor '/'search along IDL_PATH for appropriate file
I've coded the tests in a routine. If someone's interested I'll post/-email that routine.
