Good Morning,

<p>I want to read some GPS data. The distribution format has been set up for reading in fortran language. Thus, data are stored such as they can be read with fortran implicit loops (i.e. read(10,(5(f14.3,2i1)), (data1(i),data2(i),data3(i),i=1,5)). I would like to read these data with idl.

<p>On one line, 3 arrays of 5 elements each are stored (d1,d2,d3) :

<p>d1(0),d2(0),d3(0),d1(1),d2(1),d3(1),.....,d1(4),d2(4),d3(4)
