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We have recently upgraded our Sun's from SunOS 4.x to Solaris (5.x), and my call_external no longer works. I have remade the shard object library (ld flags were different), but CALL_EXTERNAL cannot find the symbol:

% CALL_EXTERNAL: Error loading sharable executable.

Symbol: _calltselec_, File = ./msis.so

msis.so is the object lib. When I use nm on msys.so and grep for calltselec I get:
