- > How do you run IDL routines from cron while maintaining IDL\_PATH and

- > I have had no trouble running my idl routines using batch or at, when
- > starting in the same directory as the main-level routine. In that case
- > my environment is copied to the spawned process.
- > Now I have the need to run these from cron. I have been able to write
- > scripts to cd to the appropriate directory and to run my .cshrc (where
- > my IDL\_PATH and other environment variables are defined), but keep
- > running into problems. The latest is than .cshrc bombs on a
- > system-level env that apparently isn't defined when running from cron.
- > So can anyone point me in the right direction?
- > I'm running { alpha OSF unix 5.3 Nov 11 1999}.

## Gwyn:

I suspect that your trouble is that you have environment variables which are being defined in your .login file rather than in .cshrc. That's pretty common practice, but one which I personally avoid. If you include the statement "source ~/.login", that should get around the problem.
