Hi, everyone -

With Deja gone and Google barely functional I have to ask here what I'm sure has been addressed before:

How do you run IDL routines from cron - while maintaining IDL_PATH and other environment variables?

I have had no trouble running my idl routines using batch or at, when starting in the same directory as the main-level routine. In that case my environment is copied to the spawned process.

Now I have the need to run these from cron. I have been able to write scripts to cd to the appropriate directory and to run my .cshrc (where my IDL_PATH and other environment variables are defined), but keep running into problems. The latest is than .cshrc bombs on a system-level env that apparently isn't defined when running from cron.

So can anyone point me in the right direction? I'm running { alpha OSF unix 5.3 Nov 11 1999}.
