Besides, it's unclear to me that this isn't a >> problem with my particular installation hardware (bp6 board with dual celerons). It may be that other, less exotic installations will >> have no problems at all. >> > \$RSI DIR/idl 5.4/bin/bin.linux.x86/idl Imgrd seems to be linked to > libc5. > I've replaced it with a copy from IDL 5.2.1L and everything works fine. > I don't think I have old libc installed on my system (SuSE 6.4. > k2.2.16). > *Interesting*.
