How about including this in your startup file:

```
tv!ct, 255B, 255B, 255B, 0  
tv!ct, 0B, 0B, 0B, !d.table_size - 1  
device, decomposed=0
```

You should get black on a white background by default:

```
plot, indgen(10)
```
