Whoops! Of course. The documentation didn't mention anything about units so, naturally, I just assumed DEVICE coordinates. I should have known better. :-(

So this works well:

IDL> set\_plot, 'ps'
IDL> device, /encap, /color, pre\_xsize=1, pre\_ysize=1, /inches, \$
IDL> Pre\_depth=8, file='test.eps', preview=2
IDL> tvimage, snap

IDL> device, /close

Takes a fraction of a second, and produces a 1 inch by 1 inch preview image that shows up nicely if I try to import it into Powerpoint.

Interestingly, the thumbnail doesn't show up if I am looking at the thumbnail view with the File Manager. File size is under 1 MByte.

Sorry for the confusion. :-)
