- > I have now tried to start idl (before licensening it). First I got two
- > error messages of two libraries missing (libXpm.so.4 and libc-so.5). I
- > just found this libs on my machine and copied it to the
- > /<IDL-DIR>/bin/bin-linux-x86 directory.
- > Now I get a segmentation fault, which is even the worst becaue it tells
- > you nothing.

Hu, does IDL 5.4 require libc5? I only have 5.2 installed, but that is already libc6. (Try ldd IDL\_DIR/bin/bin.linux/idl to see which libraries are required)

RedHat 6.2 is libc6-based, so the libXpm.so.4 is most probably for that version - maybe there is the problem. You can also use ldd libXpm.so.4 to see which version it is.
