In my particular case Dave suggested:

info.thisWindow->GetProperty, Image\_Data=snapshot

and then you can use

Write\_JPEG, filename, snapshot, True=1

to write the jpeq.

Here the display window object is in the 'info' structure and named "thisWindow"
