> Is there a way to get the current default widget font? I can define it  
> using widget\_control, default\_font = \*\*\*, but I can't seem to determine  
> what its set to. What I'd like to be able to do is define say a label  
> in a larger size of the default font. Any ideas?

As far as I know, there is no way to get at this information programmatically. IDL is picking up system font information. I can change various fonts by playing with the Appearances/Font properties on my Windows machine, but so far not the font that is used for most things in widgets. :-(
