> complicated by the fact that IDL and Fortran require the parameters to be
> passed in different ways: by value and by reference (see my post the
> 10/04/01).

In this particular case (calling fortran from IDL) that may be true, but nowadays most optimising fortran compilers (f90/95 at least) generate code that can pass arguments either by value or reference depending on which is more efficient for a particular situation.
