> Is there any way in which ticks could be added to the images, as it is done
> with contour and surface plots.

I use TV a lot, too. The way I always get my tickmarks around the sides is contour, image, /noerase, /nodata... with whatever other useful options I want, like number of tickmarks, etc. etc (see the reference manual). /nodata will put the border there, but won't draw any contour lines over the image. You may also need to set xstyle and ystyle to 1 to force the axis sizes to truncate at the end of the image.

As for the header, you can put a title on with the contour command, too. Try xyouts for various other annotations...
