> like so:

> dir_name1 = '~/prog/idl'

> dir_name2 = '~/arcsym/tools/idl'

>

> !Path = dir_name1 + ':' + !Path

> !Path = dir_name2 + ':' + !Path

>

> the IDL documentation says though that !Path only works for .pro files,
etc.

> for data files, i generally prefer specifying a string variable that has

> the entire path in it, and appending it to the filename, like:

>

> pathname = '/users/johnny/datafile'

> filename = 'foo.dat'

> fullname = pathname + '/' + filename

>
