- > CHOICE STRING = 'third'

Perhaps less neat is the (equivalent) simple array access:

```
choice = (possibilities)[key]
```

But neater still is subscripting an array built on-the-spot (again equivalent to the original):

```
choice = (['first', 'second', 'third', 'fourth'])[key]
```

Note that all parentheses and brackets are required here.
