> So, I want to find which elements of a match up with x and y.  
> Naturally, I do the following:  
>  
> index0 = WHERE(a EQ x)  
> index0 = index[0] ; convert from 1-D array to single integer.  
> index1 = WHERE(a EQ y)  
> index1 = index[0]

What is the vector "index" you reference? I think you must have meant

index0=index0[0]
