```
> Shouldn;t I be able to do something like:  
>  
> SET_PLOT,'PRINTER'  
> TVLCT,255,0,0,2  
> PLOT,myData,COLOR=2  
>  
> To print out a plot in red?
```

If you were to write your code like this:

```
PLOT,myData,COLOR=FSC_Color('Red', 2)
```

Your plot would come out red on your 24-bit display and red in your PostScript file, and red on your printer. :-)
