Sadly no. This gives the same result as:

IDL> print, get_screen_size()% Compiled module: GET_SCREEN_SIZE.1280.00 1024.00

Where 1280 by 1024 is the total size of the desktop. If I create a widget this size, part of the widget is obscured under the Windows task bar. I would like to size the widget so that it fills all of the available space (i.e. desktop size less task-bar). This is the size that a maximized window would fill.

For me, with the task-bar at the bottom of the screen, I would want the routine to return 1280 by 1000 since the task-bar takes up 24 pixels vertically. However the task-bar can live up the side of the screen.
