along...

- > Is it -in principle- possible to use the dataminer
- > in combination with a MySQL-Database? There is a
- > ODBC-Driver for MySQL but I have not seen any
- > "success-stories" in the archive at groups.google.com!

If there's an ODBC driver then Dataminer should work. Lack of success
stories just indicates the small number of people who do this kind of thing.

- > A very special question: The tables in our MySQL-database
- > contain fields with type DATETIME. According to the manual
- > there is no corresponding IDL-Type to DATETIME, will I
- > be able to use these tables at all in IDL?

You should have no problems. As I recall, there *is* an IDL structure type
corresponding to SQL's DATETIME. It's called ODBC_SQL_TIMESTAMP
