I really appreciate all the advice I received since I posted my original question, either through private e-mails or appearing in here. What a friendly newsgroup!

However, the advice to use 'spawn' would not help me since I am using IDL for Windows, in which the keyword of "unit" in spawn command is forbidden. I know "spawn 'gzip -c' unit=lun" can be used in Unix as the manual tells me. In MS-DOS, the "spawn" is limited to the output of line number, not as the file unit in Unix.

Well, I will try to convert that ASCII file to binary format so IDL can read quick, at least for the time being.
