Did you know something of the compatibility of HDF5 to HDF4 and HDF3. If it's not compatibel then I believe it's no chance to get it supported.

I asked many times for a newer version of netCDF. 3.6 is the latest release at the moment but in IDL it's 2.4.

There was a problem with the compatibility of HDF in newer versions. HDF,CDF and netCDF are the scientific dataformats which are included to idl.

They won't upgrade only one format because they are added as package and I always get the answer that they won't upgrade because of the incompatibilty
