You can get rid of the "C-c C-d" prefix with something like:

```
(setq idlwave-shell-debug-modifiers '(hyper))
```

Part of the doc blurb:

"If you set this to '(control shift), this means setting a breakpoint will be on `C-S-b', compiling a source file on `C-S-c' etc. Possible modifiers are `control', `meta', `super', `hyper', `alt', and `shift'."
