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If I have array a[3,50] and array b[3], how do I fill all rows of a with the row vector b? For example, what I want to do is

```
a = intarr(3,50)
b = [6,5,4]
a[0:2,*] = b ;or a[*,*] = b
```

a should now look like

```
[6,5,4]
[6,5,4]
[6,5,4]
[6,5,4]
...
```

I thought I could use replicate or makearray, like..

```
a = REPLICATE(b, n_elements(b), 50)
```

or

```
a = MAKE_ARRAY(n_elements(b), 50, /INTEGER, VALUE= b)
```
