- > obj\_destroy, myclipbrd

>

- > The name "IDLgrClipboard" is a little confusing. It was originally intended
- > only for output to the system clipboard, but then the IDL developers
- > thought, "Hey, we could use this to write files too."

I just point out what is probably obvious: this produces PostScript output, not \*encapsulated\* PostScript output as was requested in the original post.

To get encapsulated PostScript output, you have to convert PostScript files somewhere other than in IDL.
