> of operations is

>   myview = [Create & populate your IDLgrView here]
>   myclipbrd = obj_new('IDLgrClipboard')
>   myclipbrd->Draw, /VECTOR, /POSTSCRIPT, FILENAME=[your file name here]
>   obj_destroy, myclipbrd
>
> The name "IDLgrClipboard" is a little confusing. It was originally intended
> only for output to the system clipboard, but then the IDL developers
> thought, "Hey, we could use this to write files too."
```

I just point out what is probably obvious: this produces PostScript output, not *encapsulated* PostScript output as was requested in the original post.

To get encapsulated PostScript output, you have to convert PostScript files somewhere other than in IDL.
