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Yes,

Try these commands.

plot, indgen(10) ! Plots to window 0 (Default)

window, /free ! Gives you an additional window (we'll say #32)

plot, indgen(20) ! Plots to new window (32)

wset, 0 ! Return to window (0)

plot, indgen(40) ! Plots to window 0

Hope that answers your question.

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
