Hello,

I have a plotting program running on a windows computer, and the problem is sometimes it works and sometimes it doesn't (the exact same program with nothing changed). When it doesn't work, most of the plot is made fine, except that none of the lines from the "Plots" commands are drawn. The gist of the program is ...
