Not that this is a perl list, but try:

```
#!/usr/bin/perl
open(IDL, "|/usr/local/bin/idl");
print IDL ".Compile loop \n":
print IDL "loop \n";
close IDL; #THIS ONE CRITICAL
@ary=(5,6,7,8);
for (@ary) {
  print "$_\n";
}
```

Since you weren't closing the filehandle, the IDL input was not being flushed, until after the program exited (at which point it was forced close).
