Hi Barry,

here is what we ended up doing. We are submitting to an AGU journal, which requires CMYK eps or TIFFs. I read in the postscript figure in question

(produced by IDL) into Paintshop pro (an inexpensive Windows program by Jasc Software). I used that program to create a CMYK TIFF files (compressed)

and submitted that.

You can download the paintshop pro program and take it for a 30 day (?) trial. I find it comes in handy for image editing.
