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Someone else must have encountered this problem, but I can't find any mention of it in the FAQ or documentation. I generated an EPS figure for publication using IDL. The journal, however, wants figures as EPS in CMYK color mode instead of RGB. Is there a way to do this in IDL? I've tried using Adobe Illustrator (which will do the conversion) but two of my figures are too large for the amount of memory I have (128M) on the machine that hosts Illustrator. I've also tried using ImageMagick, but without success. Thanks.
