> There are ~11,000 files in that folder. This isn't (?) a problem since the
> command works with the file name part = '*' as opposed to '*.dat'.

Actually, this leads me to believe that you might indeed be running into a problem with the total number of files. The find_file.pro procedure I posted earlier might help you.

The core of that routine is using spawn,/noshell. You might be able to do the same thing with a command like

```
spawn,/noshell,['find',subdirectory,'-name','*.dat','-print' ],files
```
