

Reading your latest press release, it would seem that IDL version 5.5 will be the last version for the macintosh and no version of IDL for OS X will be available. I understand the difficulty in porting IDL to OS X, and would not be too dissapointed if an OS X version of IDL was delayed indefinitely until the economy improves as long as the "classic" version of IDL for Macintosh was continued.

With the Unix underpinnings of Mac OS X and the availability of free or open-source data-processing, graphing, and visualization software (such as Vis-5D, GRADS, IBM data explorer, NCAR graphics), there are many other alternatives that one has to work interchangeably between Macintosh, linux PCs, and Solaris workstations. IDL will no longer be one of the alternatives that I use.
