On that front, I have two corrections and one addition:

Correction 1) From earlier, I relayed that RSI sales were down 50% from 1999-2000. That was incorrect. _Mac_ sales at RSI have been down 50% each year for the past _3_ years.

Correction 2) I relayed Apple gave RSI a G4 to help their Mac effort. That was incorrect. Apple gave several machines and good general hardware support. RSI, however needed/needs other types of support as well - critical things like documentation help, engineering resource support, etc.
