It is curious there's a FILE\_DELETE IDL command, but no file copy? Huh.

How about:

```
CASE ( STRUPCASE( !VERSION.OS_FAMILY ) ) OF
```

```
'UNIX': SPAWN, 'cp ' + from_file + ' ' + to_file
```

```
'MACOS': SPAWN, <whatever the Mac command is>
```

```
'WIN': SPAWN, <whatever the Windows command is>
```

```
'VMS': SPAWN, <whatever the VMS command is>
```

```
ELSE: 'IDL on PDP 11/70 is no longer supported :o)
```

```
ENDCASE
```

Of course the non-unix results for !VERSION.OS\_FAMILY above are made up. :o)
